The High School and Young Adults Pastor is responsible for the spiritual formation of high school students and young adults. As a pastor, you are discipling students, providing pastoral care, and leading the organized ministry activities for high school students and young adults. You will lead and continue to develop teams of leaders who will build Christ centered relationships with participants. Key methods will include strong biblical teaching, engaging challenging topics and conversations, worship, mentoring relationships, small groups, retreats/mission experiences as well as stimulating/captivating events and experiences.

Your ministry will flow from your love of Jesus Christ. You are a high-capacity leader with strong relational skills and organizational strength. The primary focus of your position is to provide leadership and to equip persons to be disciples who make disciples. You will help shape and champion Eastview's understanding of youth and young adult culture, including the implementation of strategies for engaging this age-group in the life of the larger church. In partnering with other pastoral staff you will foster discipleship in youth and young adults.

Eastview At A Glance

In the fall of 2022, 115 Jr and Sr High students have participated with a weekly attendance ranging between 50-75. Of the 69 gr 9-12 high school students 43 are part of Eastview households.

Presently youth ministry spans gr 7-12. This Job posting anticipates a change in youth ministry design beginning June of 2023. At that time High School ministry (9-12) will function independently and middle school ministry (5-8) will function within the Family Ministry Team.

In the fall of 2022, 29 young adults are active in a life group within Eastview. 18 young adults serve weekly as youth leaders and many others serve in other areas. In total 79 young adults are actively involved at Eastview.

Eastview Community Church is a suburban church on the northern edge of Winnipeg in East St. Paul. In the fall of 2022, our average Sunday participation ranges from 300 to 375 people across all ages.

Eastview has a staff team of 10 people, five of which are Pastoral roles and a Leadership Board which includes 6 men and women, plus the Lead Pastor. Presently 329 people actively use their spiritual gifts as volunteers, and 172 people are active in one of our 16 Life Groups. As a congregation we call and support women as leaders in all aspects of church life including leadership board and pastoral staff.

- Must complete the Pastoral Credentialing process of the Mennonite Brethren Church of Manitoba within the first 6 months of employment
- A criminal record check is required for this position
