



Worship Leader (part-time)

Position Summary:

The Worship Leader is responsible for choosing music and leading worship at the main 10:00am Sunday service. The music at this service is a blend of traditional and contemporary led by piano, with support from our historic pipe organ. Other instruments are welcome and often included.

The successful candidate will know and love the Lord Jesus with passion and commitment, and have a high level of musical knowledge and skill in both piano and voice. The person will embrace both traditional hymns and contemporary worship songs and have an appreciation for Anglican liturgical worship. The successful candidate will serve alongside our volunteer organist. Experience in conducting a choir is an asset but not a requirement.

The Worship Leader will be able to recruit and train volunteer musicians/singers and will seek to be part of our church family. A working knowledge of the CCLI database is a requirement.

Key Responsibilities

- Choose and lead music from the piano for the Sunday service, which combines traditional and contemporary music
- Choose and lead music at special services when required (eg. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Christmas Eve)
- Recruit and train volunteers for worship team
- Meet regularly with clergy to plan and evaluate services

General

- 6-month probationary period
- 2-weeks paid vacation each calendar year

 - Current criminal record check
 - Health/Safety/Conduct policy of the Anglican Network in Canada
